RECOMMENDED BALANCE BRACE USES

- **Balance Rehabilitation**- use during balance therapy for better patient compliance, quicker response to treatment and better outcomes.
- **Fall Risk**- use during patient ambulation and transfers to provide stability through corrected foot position and decreased ankle sway.
- **Vestibular Balance Disorders**- studies show improved gaze stabilization with the Brace through limited ankle motion.
- **Foot Drop**- use to correct patient's foot position, greatly improving stability and gait.
- **Diabetic Neuropathy**- the Brace is custom fit to the patient and built by a diabetic shoe manufacturer with special padding to protect the patient's feet from "hot spots" and rubbing injuries.
